



# WESTON ROAD / WESTON COYNEY ROAD / NEW KINGSWAY IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

### NOTES :

A minimum 2.2m footway is to be retained throughout.

All carriageway markings will be refreshed in line with the design proposals.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout the works.

### Why are we proposing these improvements?

There are a number of reasons why we are proposing to carry out works in this area:

1. To improve safety for pedestrians at Weston Road / New Kingsway junction;
2. To improve access to public transport;
3. To improve vehicle movement at the junction; and
4. To improve vehicle movement along New Kingsway.

### What are we doing?

To achieve our aims we are proposing:

1. To improve pedestrian movements at Weston Road / New Kingsway junction by installing pedestrian refuges;
2. To improve access to public transport by installing a new Bus Stop north of the pedestrian crossing;
3. To improve vehicle movement at the junction by installing right-turn lanes and carriageway detector loops; and
4. To improve vehicle movement along New Kingsway by widening the carriageway allowing two way traffic flows whilst providing parking.

### What happens next?

Depending on the outcome of the consultation and subject to funds being available works will commence in 2015.

All residents, businesses and the school will be kept informed of the programme as it developed / agreed.
